


Navigating IntelliWriter™

Comments Tab: This tab will show any comments you or those you've given "Comment" permissions for the document. Note: Users with "Read" and "Write" permissions will not be able to make or see comments.



Comments Tab: To make a comment, highlight the section of text you want to comment on, and click the comment icon.


